MVC900 II Connection

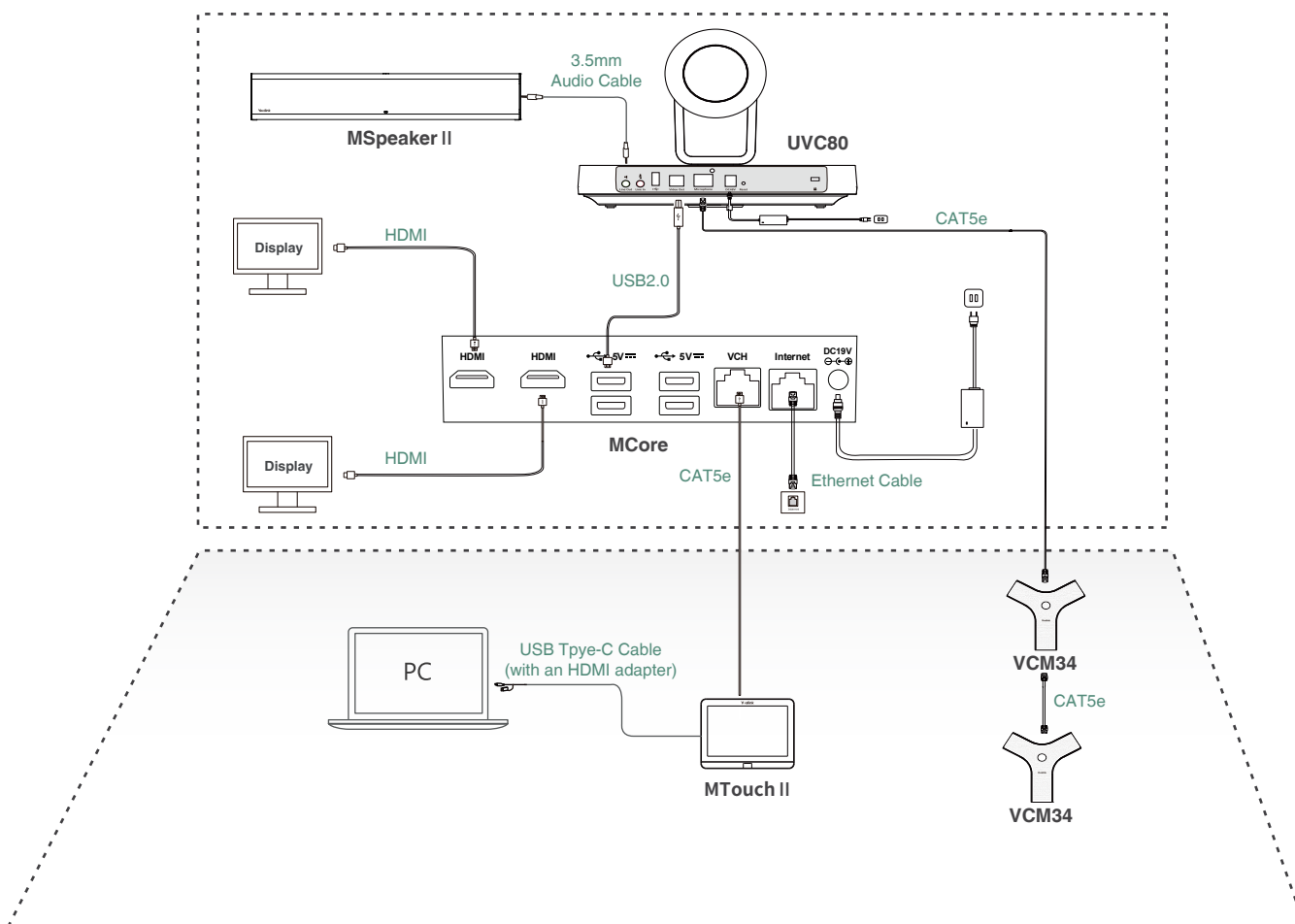

MVC800 II & MVC500 II Connection

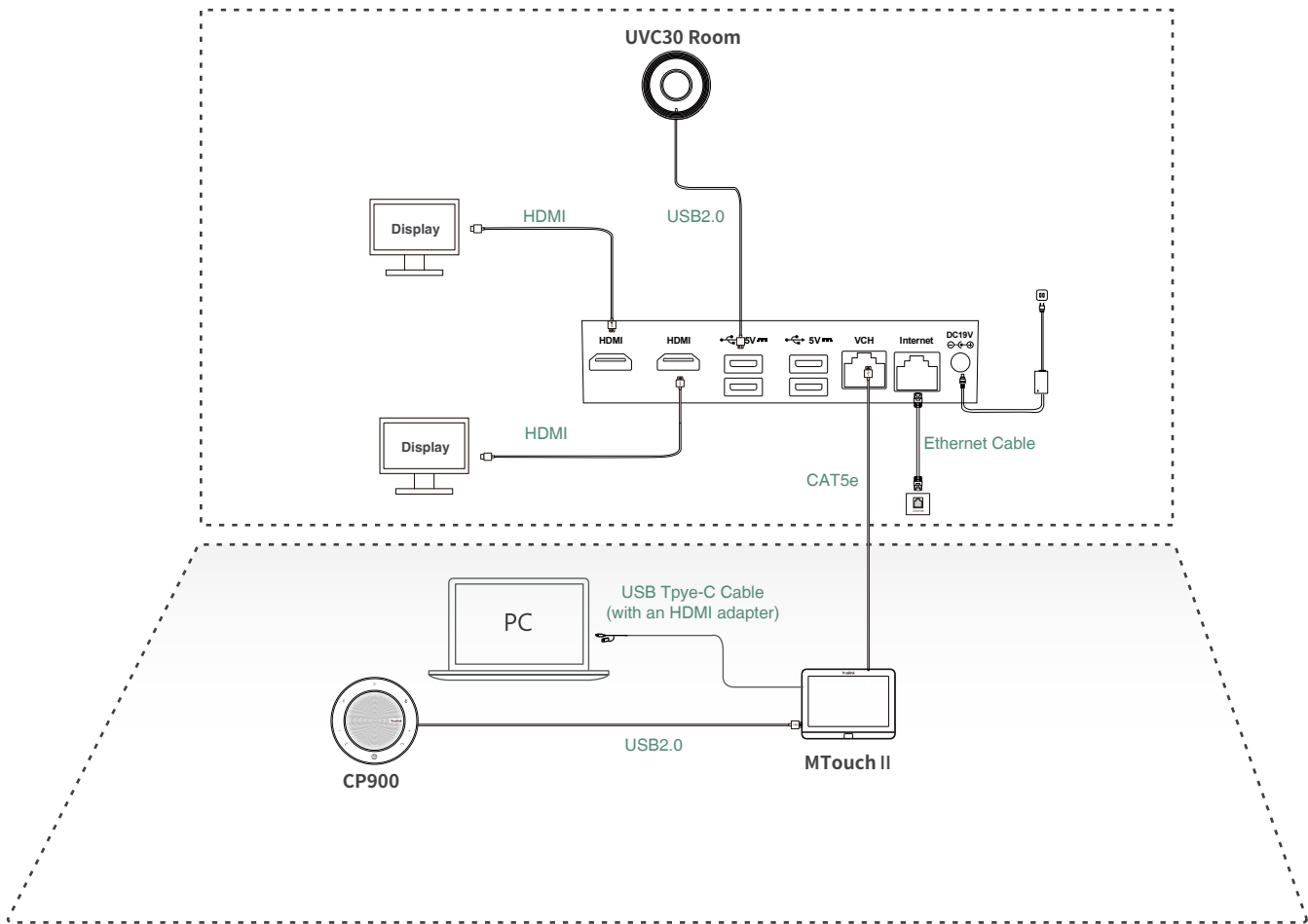
The connection of MVC500 II is almost the same as that of MVC800 II .

MVC300 II Connection

Wireless Sharing

You can use Yealink WPP20 wireless presentation pod for wireless content sharing. WPP20 needs to be purchased separately.

Make sure the MTouch II is connected to the MCore.

Procedure

1. Connect the WPP20 to the USB port of the MTouch II .
2. Wait for about 3 seconds, the WPP20 LED indicator glows solid green.
The WPP20 is paired with the MTouch II successfully.
3. Connect the WPP20 to the PC.



Upgrading System Software through Windows Update

The system software(including the Windows, the Camera-Hub/UVC80/UVC50/UVC30 Room, the MTouch II) can be automatically upgraded via windows update by default.

Otherwise, you can enable automatically windows update or upgrade the devices manually.

Enabling Automatically Windows Update

Procedure

1. On the display screen, navigate to **More->Settings**.
2. Enter the administrator password (default: sfb) to access **Setup** screen.
3. Navigate to **Windows Settings**.
4. Select **Administrator** from the bottom-left corner and then enter the administrator password (default: sfb).
5. Tap the Start button, and then go to **Settings->Upgrade & Security->Windows Update**, and select **Advanced options**.
6. Enable **Automatically download updates, even over metered data connections (charge may apply)**.

Manually Windows Update



Procedure

1. On the display screen, navigate to **More->Settings**.
2. Enter the administrator password (default: sfb) to access **Setup** screen.
3. Navigate to **Windows Settings**.
4. Select **Administrator** from the bottom-left corner and then enter the administrator password (default: sfb).
5. Do one of the following:
 - Long tap the Start button, and then select **Device Manager**.
Select the desired device and then long tap the device to select **Update driver**.
Select a desired way to update.
 - Tap the Start button, and then navigate to **Settings->Upgrade & Security->Windows Update**, and select **Check for updates**.
Select the desired device and then complete the installation.

 The software upgrade is only supported by the operating system of 64-bit Windows 10.





Enabling/Disabling Auto-framing

Procedure

1. Tap **More**->  to enter the **Camera Control** page.
2. Select  .
3. Enable/Disable **Auto-framing**.


Controlling UVC80/UVC50/UVC30 Room Camera Position

Procedure

1. Tap **More**->  to enter the **Camera Control** page.
 2. If you are using MVC900 II system, select a desired UVC80 camera.
 3. Tap  or  to zoom camera in/out.
 4. Tap the arrow keys to pan/tilt the camera.
-  If the auto-framing feature is enabled, you can not control the UVC30 Room camera.

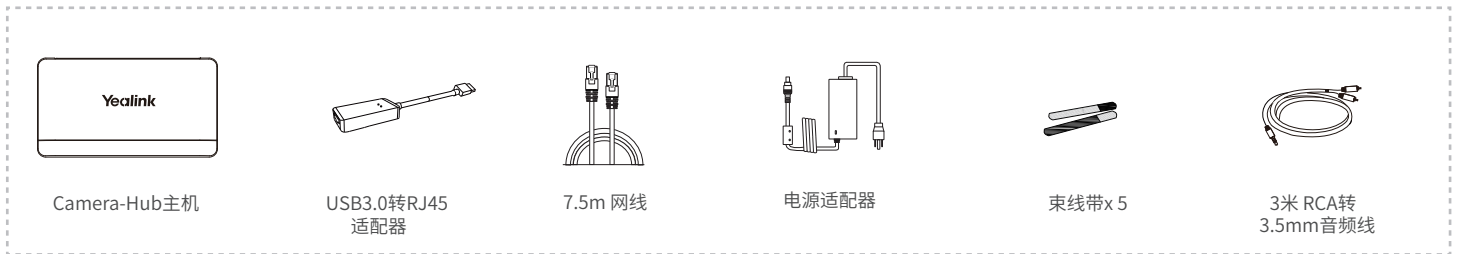
Resetting UVC80/UVC50/UVC30 Room Camera to Home Position

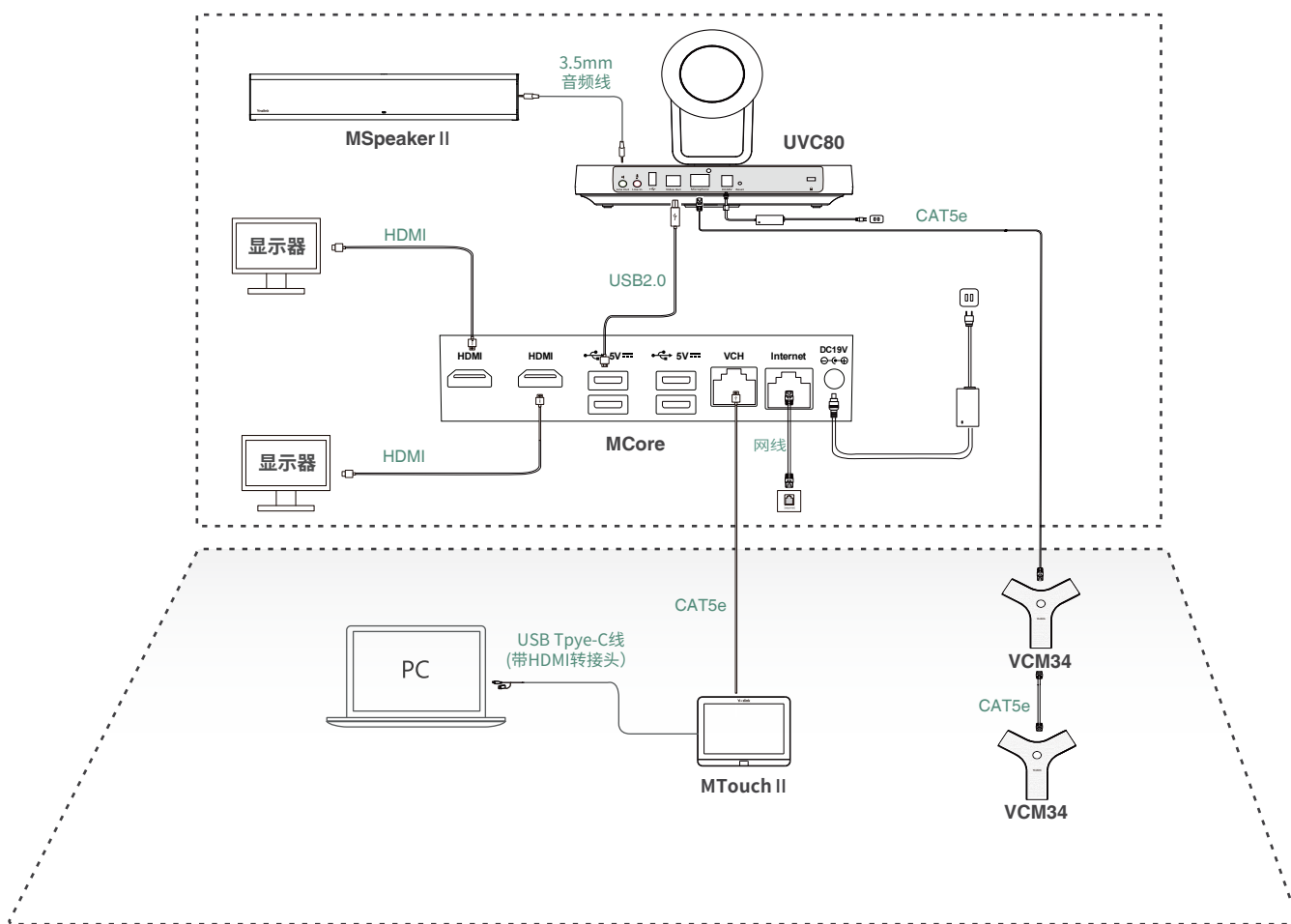

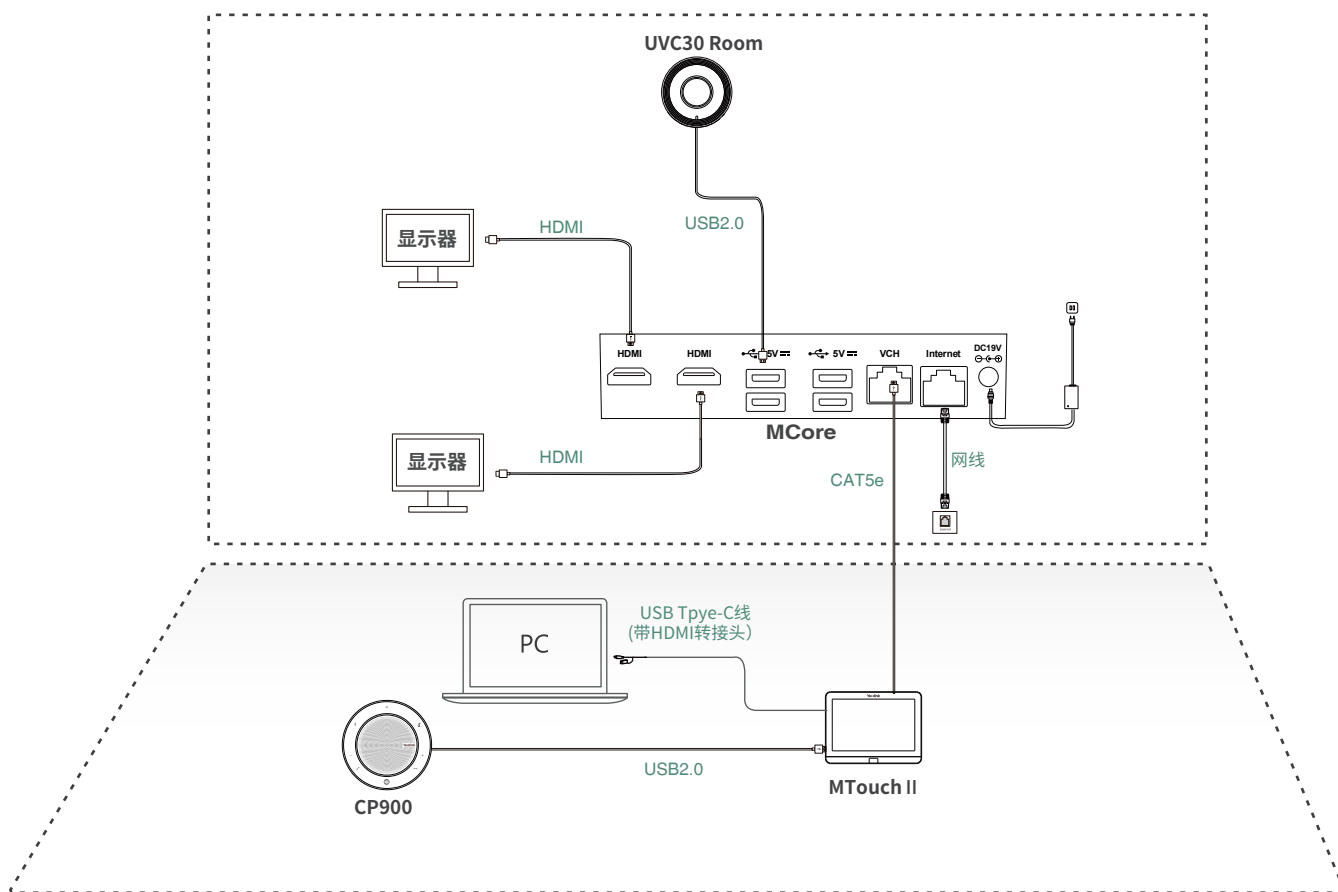

通过Windows更新系统

系统软件(包括Windows, Camera-Hub/UVC80/UVC50/UVC30 Room和 MTouch II)默认情况下可以通过windows 自动更新升级。如果设备软件没有自动升级,你可以启用自动windows 自动更新或手动升级设备。

开启Windows自动更新

过程

1. 在显示屏上,按**更多->设置**。
2. 输入管理员密码(默认:sfb)进入**设置**界面。
3. 按 **Windows设置**。
4. 从左下角选择**Administrator**帐户,并输入管理员帐户密码(默认:sfb)。
5. 按开始菜单,选择**设置->更新和安全->Windows更新**,再按**高级选项**。
